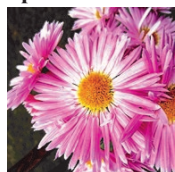
Turtle Facts



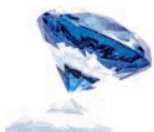
Wood turtles stomp their front feet against the ground.

Baked Meat Balls



From College of the Ozarks'
Edwards Mill Cookbook

Ingredients

- 1 pound hamburger
- 1 egg
- 1 teaspoon chopped green pepper
- 1 Tablespoon chopped onion
- 1 teaspoon dry

mustard

- 1 teaspoon chili powder
- 1/2 cup milk
- 1/4 cup cornmeal
- Milk
- Flour
- 1 can tomato soup

Directions

- Mix all ingredients and make into balls.
- Dip in milk and roll in flour.
- Brown in a skillet.
- Place in baking dish and pour can of tomato soup over meatballs.
- Bake at 350° in a covered dish for 40 to 45 minutes.
