A turtle's upper shell is called a "carpace;" the lower is called a "plastron." Some turtles have a moveable joint, called a "hinge," that allows them to pull the carpace and plastron tightly shut, when the turtle retreats into its shell.



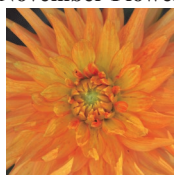
Pet of the Month
