Old-Fashioned Vegetable Soup

Ingredients

- 1 pound ground beef
- 1 cup chopped onion •
- 1 cup diced raw potatoes
- 1 cup sliced carrots
- 1 cup sliced celery

- 2 16-ounce cans whole tomatoes. chopped coarsely
- 5 cups water
- 1 Tablespoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon basil
- 1/4 teaspoon thyme
- 1 bay leaf
- 1/4 teaspoon pepper
- 2 Tablespoons beef bouillon granules
- 1 7-ounce can whole kernel corn. undrained
 - 1 8.5-ounce can green beans. undrained
- 1 8.5-ounce can peas, undrained

Directions

- In a large Dutch oven or pot, cook ground beef and onion until meat is slightly browned; drain.
- Add remaining ingredients, except corn, green beans, and peas.
- Simmer 30 minutes, until vegetables are tender.
- Add canned vegetables and cook 5 minutes more.
- Serve and enjoy!
